Model Music Curriculum 2021

Our Plan

We have been creating music curriculum resources for Key Stage 2 for the last 2 years. The recently released March 2021 Model Music Curriculum already aligns with what we have been doing and we have made minor adjustments to our future plans to ensure alignment remains.

Our Resources

Each Musician of the Month pack that we create contains a biographical knowledge organiser and mini-quiz. We also provide a range of other activities such as listening activities, geography, music videos and lessons which explore their musical or cultural importance.

We have also started providing a 30-minute music assembly for each musician. This can be watched by children at school or remotely or may be used as CPD for staff. Lessons include the following: breathing exercises, body percussion, tongue twisters, notation, singing warm-ups, information about the musician, listen/respond activities and singing practice. Each session will also involve some of the indicative musical features (elements) that give language to concepts such as pulse and rhythm, pitch and melody, structure and form etc.

Resources can be used as part of a 'Musician of the Month' or allocated to specific year groups. A space is left for you to allocate them should you wish to. We would recommend using the idea of a 'Musician of the Month' and continually roll the 4-year program, as this could then be used in school assemblies as well as creating consistency and focus through school and, at the same time, allowing for staff discussions, training and support.

This document will be updated each month. Resources in red are currently pending and we will be continuing to make these resources on a monthly basis. Once complete, we may continue making further resources to ensure schools can substitute musicians to suit their own needs.
